Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN SEN, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will send his written address to the virtual Global COVID-19 Summit under the theme "Ending the Pandemic and Building Back Better", to be hosted by His Excellency Joe Biden, President of the United States of America, on 22 September 2021. The Summit will focus on vaccinating the world, saving lives, building back better health security, and acting for progress, and agreement on the targets.

Samdech Techo Prime Minister HUN SEN's remarks will underscore the urgent need to jointly stop COVID-19 pandemic with sincere humanitarian spirit and without any hidden political agenda, in order to enable safe resumption of socio-economic activities.
