The Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation wishes to inform the public that the Kingdom of Cambodia has been elected as member of the Executive Board of the United Nations Development Programme/United Nations Population Fund/United Nations Office for Project Services for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 2018 and expiring on 31 December 2020.

The election of Cambodia's candidature by the United Nations Economic and Social Council (ECOSOC) reconfirmed the international recognition of the Kingdom's increasing important role that it can play to contribute to agenda-setting on specific theme of sustainable development.

As a fast-growing economy with remarkable performance on poverty reduction as well as the Millennium Development Goals, Cambodia is confident that its experiences could be beneficial to the United Nations' endeavor to address global development issues.
