Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN SEN, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will lead a high delegation to pay an Official Working Visit to Japan from 06 to 09 August 2017, at the invitation of the Government of Japan.

Samdech Techo Prime Minister will be accompanied by the following dignitaries:

- H.E. Dr. AUN Porn Moniroth, Senior Minister and Minister of Economy and Finance,
- H.E. Mr. OUK Rabun, Minister of Rural Development,
- H.E. Mr. THONG Khon, Minister of Tourism, and other members of the Royal Government of Cambodia.

During his stay in Japan, Samdech Techo Prime Minister will pay a courtesy call on His Imperial Highness Crown Prince Naruhito of Japan.

After attending the Welcoming Ceremony, Samdech Techo Prime Minister will hold a Summit Meeting with H.E. Shinzo Abe, Japanese Prime Minister, and before proceeding to a Joint Press Announcement, the two Prime Ministers will preside over the signing ceremony of two following documents on Japanese assistance to Cambodia:

- A Grant Aid of Yen 3,948 million, approximately USD 35 million for the implementation of the Project for Flood Protection and Drainage Improvement in the Phnom Penh Capital City (Phase IV); and
- A concessional loan of Yen 23,502 million, approximately USD 209 million, for implementing the Sihanoukville Port New Container Terminal Development Project.
