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**Outcomes of the Signing Ceremony of the Joint Declaration
by the Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia
and the Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Thailand**

26 October 2025, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia

On 26 October 2025, at the invitation of H.E. Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim, Prime Minister of Malaysia and Chair of ASEAN for 2025, **Samdech Moha Borvor Thipadei HUN Manet**, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, together with H.E. **Anutin Charnvirakul**, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Thailand, attended the Signing Ceremony of the Kuala Lumpur Joint Declaration between the Kingdom of Cambodia and the Kingdom of Thailand, in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. The Ceremony was also witnessed by H.E. **Donald J. Trump**, President of the United States of America and **Prime Minister Dato' Seri Anwar Ibrahim**.

Today marks a historic moment of profound significance for Cambodia and Thailand — a day that reaffirms our shared conviction that peace is always possible when nations have the courage and wisdom to pursue it together.
