His Excellency PRAK Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will co-chair with His Excellency Dr. Subrahmanyam Jaishankar, Minister of External Affairs of the Republic of India, the 11<sup>th</sup> Mekong-Ganga Foreign Ministers' Meeting (11<sup>th</sup> MGC FMM) which will be held on 21 July 2021 via video conference. Other Foreign Ministers from the Mekong countries namely Lao PDR, Myanmar, Thailand and Viet Nam will also attend the meeting.

The MGC Foreign Ministers will review the progress of the cooperation since the 10<sup>th</sup> MGC Ministerial Meeting in Bangkok on 01 August 2019 and chart out its future direction, aiming at further strengthening and expanding the Mekong-Ganga Cooperation in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Ministers are also expected to exchange views on regional and international issues of common interest and concern.

The virtual 11<sup>th</sup> MGC FMM represents another achievement under the MGC in the past 21 years in realizing economic growth and social development in the Mekong sub-region and India, while enhancing cooperation between India and the Mekong countries through cultural and people-to-people ties. To mark the cooperation's 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary, there will be a launching of a brand new MGC website and the presentation of a video documentary showcasing the achievements of the cooperation and the diverse cultures and societies of the member countries.
