At the invitation of His Excellency Moon Jae-in, President of the Republic of Korea, Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN SEN, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, will participate in the Second P4G Summit – Partnering for Green Growth and the Global Goals 2030, to be held virtually on 31 May 2021 in Seoul, the Republic of Korea.

Under the theme "Inclusive Green Recovery towards Carbon Neutrality", Samdech Techo Prime Minister will deliver a substantive statement on the topic of "Inclusive Green Recovery from COVID-19" at the Leaders' Dialogue Session, which will focus on (1) the need to adjust policies and resources to successfully overcome the COVID-19 pandemic, (2) negative impacts of climate change on security and socioeconomic development, and (3) the importance of green recovery for sustainable development. Samdech Techo will also share his insightful and practical recommendations with the Summit for resilient and sustainable development for the post COVID-19 crisis.

It is worth noting that the P4G, a global initiative launched in 2017, serves as a multilateral venue for government, businesses, and civil society to work together to respond to climate change and achieve the SDGs by providing innovative solutions. The second P4G Seoul Summit will bring together the international community's collective commitment to build back a better and greener world from the COVID-19 crisis.
