STATEMENT

of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation

Cambodia regrets and expresses its grave concern over the nuclear test conducted by the Democratic People's Republic of Korea (DPRK) on 03 September 2017. This sixth nuclear test is a repeated violation of the relevant United Nations Security Council (UNSC) Resolutions and poses serious threat to peace, security and stability in the Korean Peninsula, and in this region as a whole and will further deteriorate the already tense situation in the Korean Peninsula.

Cambodia urges the DPRK to fully comply with all relevant UNSC Resolutions and its international obligations and to cease all nuclear and missile tests in order to safeguard peace and stability in the Korean Peninsula.
