

## Updates on the situation along the Cambodia-Thailand border

### 4 July 2025:

- **Spokesperson of the Ministry of National Defence of Cambodia –**

- (1) From the midnight of 4 August 2025 until 06h10AM, the situation along the frontlines in Preah Vihear and Oddar Meanchey provinces remained calm and stable. The Cambodian armed forces continue to stand strong, fully vigilant, and committed to fulfilling their duties.
- (2) On the afternoon of 3 August 2025, the delegation from the Secretariat of the Cambodia-Thailand General Border Committee (GBC) arrived in Malaysia to attend the Principles of Ceasefire and Confidence Building Measures Meeting, scheduled for 4-6 August 2025, to be followed by the Extraordinary Session of the Cambodia-Thailand General Border Committee on 7 August 2025.
- (3) As of now, 18 Cambodian military personnel remain under Thai custody since 7:50 AM on 29 July 2025. The government of Cambodia urges the Thai side to promptly repatriate the remaining personnel in accordance with international law.
- (4) **Thai armed forces laid barbed wire in Cambodian soil –** At 11h00 a.m, on 4 August 2025, Thai armed forces accompanied by heavy machinery (excavators), entered An Ses area in Preah Vihear province in Cambodia, and laid barbed wire –the same location visited by military attaché from 13 countries on July 30, 2025. This act constitutes a flagrant violation of the ceasefire and poses a grave threat to peace and security along the border between the two countries, as well as the wider region.
