At the invitation of His Excellency PRAK Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of the Kingdom of Cambodia, His Excellency WANG Yi, State Councilor and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the People's Republic of China, will pay an official visit to the Kingdom of Cambodia on 12-13 September 2021.

During the visit, His Excellency WANG Yi will pay a courtesy call on Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN SEN, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, and have a working breakfast with His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister HOR Namhong.

His Excellency WANG Yi will hold a bilateral meeting with His Excellency Deputy Prime Minister PRAK Sokhonn, during which various aspects of bilateral cooperation such as the fight against COVID-19, trade and investment, education, security and national defense, as well as regional and international issues of common interest and concern will be discussed.

Samdech Techo Prime Minister HUN SEN and His Excellency WANG Yi, with the participation of Samdech Pichey Sena TEA Banh, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of National Defence and Chairman of Cambodian SEA Games Organizing Committee (CAMSOC), and H.E. Dr. THONG Khon, Minister of Tourism and Vice Chairman of CAMSOC, will preside over the handover ceremony of the Morodok Techo National Stadium which will be the centerpiece venue for Cambodia's 2023 SEA Games.
