Cambodia, Japan to Elevate Relations to "Comprehensive Strategic Partnership"

Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo HUN Sen, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia, and His Excellency KISHIDA Fumio, Prime Minister of Japan, jointly announced their agreement to elevate the Cambodia-Japan relations to "Comprehensive Strategic Partnership" on the occasion of the 70th Anniversary of the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the two countries next year, during a Bilateral Meeting held on 12 November 2022 on the margins of the ASEAN Summits and Related Summits.

Samdech Techo Prime Minister HUN Sen and His Excellency KISHIDA noted with satisfaction the existing excellent Cambodia-Japan ties, recalling the two visits to Cambodia by the Japanese Prime Minister and the two visits to Japan by Samdech Techo Prime Minister this year alone. Both Leaders stressed the importance of the longstanding relations and expressed their commitment to further strengthening cooperation in all fields. Samdech Techo Prime Minister highly valued Japan's major contribution to Cambodia's socio-economic development and thanked Japan for its assistance with Cambodia's electoral reforms. Samdech also called on his Japanese counterpart to assist Cambodia to reach its goal of "A Mine-Free Cambodia by 2025".

His Excellency KISHIDA praised Samdech Techo Prime Minister for his able ASEAN Chairmanship and fully supported Cambodia's initiatives to strengthen ASEAN Centrality and unity to bring about tangible results for ASEAN community and to address common challenges facing the region.
