At the invitation of His Excellency DATO ERYWAN PEHIN YUSOF, Minister of Foreign Affairs II of Brunei Darussalam, His Excellency PRAK Sokhonn, Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation of Cambodia, will participate in the ASEAN Foreign Ministers' (AMM) Retreat, which will be held on 21 January 2021 via videoconference.

The AMM Retreat will follow-up on the leaders' guidance from the 37th ASEAN Summit on the review the ASEAN Blueprints, ways and means to realize the ASEAN Community building in light of the current global context and COVID-19 pandemic and on charting ASEAN Community Vision Post-2025. ASEAN Foreign Ministers are expected to also discuss ASEAN's post-COVID-19 recovery plan and engagement with the global community.

Brunei Darussalam will lead ASEAN process this year under the Theme "We Care, We Prepare, We Prosper" with three key priorities that mainly focus on harnessing the caring nature of ASEAN; preparing and adapting for the future; and creating opportunities for the benefit of ASEAN people.
